## Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA)

### Data Protection Policy

The purpose of this document (“Data Protection Policy”) is to inform you on how Canossaville Children & Community Services (Canossaville) manages Personal Data which is subject to the Singapore Personal Data Protection Act (No. 26 of 2012) (“the Act”). Please take a moment to read this Data Protection Policy so that you know and understand the purposes for which we collect and use your Personal Data.

The Data Protection Policy supplements but does not replace any other consents you may have previously provided to CANOSSAVILLE in respect of your Personal Data.

CANOSSAVILLE may from time to time update the Data Protection Policy to ensure that the Data Protection Policy is consistent with our future developments and/or any changes in legal or regulatory requirements. Subject to your rights at law, you agree to be bound by the prevailing terms of the Data Protection Policy as updated from time to time on this page.

#### 1. Personal Data

In this Data Protection Policy, “Personal Data” refers to any data, whether true or not, about an individual who can be identified (a) from that data; or (b) from that data and other information to which we have or are likely to have access, including data in our records as may be updated from time to time.

#### 2. Collection of Personal Data

We collect Personal Data in the following ways:

- (a) when you submit a sponsorship form or form to CANOSSAVILLE in relation to fundraising, awareness and or any other events and or campaign;
- (b) when you attend a CANOSSAVILLE event or engage a CANOSSAVILLE staff and you give us your Business Card.

You should ensure that all Personal Data submitted to us is complete, accurate, true and correct. Failure on your part to do so may result in our inability to provide you with information regarding our events and activities.

#### 3. Purposes for the Collection and Use of Your Personal Data

CANOSSAVILLE collects and uses your Personal Data for the following purposes:

- (a) to keep you updated about CANOSSAVILLE activities including but not limited to fundraising events, awareness campaigns, via newsletters, by email blast, email, mail or phone call;
- (b) to facilitate tax exemption for your donations made to CANOSSAVILLE, according to the information provided. Kindly note that all donations are submitted to IRAS for tax exemption at the end of calendar year. Your 250% tax exemption will be automatically reflected on your tax filing the following year, corresponding to your donation amount.
- (c) to keep you in the loop with all the changes within CANOSSAVILLE (e.g. the new board of Directors) by email blast, email, mail or phone call.

#### 4. Disclosure of Personal Data

CANOSSAVILLE protects your Personal Data against unauthorised disclosure. Subject to the provisions of any applicable law, your Personal Data may be disclosed, for the purposes listed above.

#### 5. Contacting Us - Withdrawal of Consent, Access and Correction of your Personal Data

If you:

- (a) have any questions or feedback relating to your Personal Data or our Data Protection Policy;
- (b) would like to withdraw your consent to any use of your Personal Data as set out in this Data Protection Policy; or
